Tallulah Gorge Fall Victim Identified

TALLULAH FALLS, GA – This afternoon, Georgia DNR Game Wardens, along with Habersham County and Rabun County EMS personnel, responded to Tallulah Gorge State Park regarding a report of an individual who fell from Overlook 2 in the park. The first responders located the deceased female at the bottom of the gorge and Habersham and Rabun County personnel rappelled into the Gorge and used long lines to recover the victim. The DNR Law Enforcement Critical Incident Reconstruction Team is investigating the incident. The deceased has been positively identified as Nancy Moore Smith, age 58, of Blue Ridge. No further information is available until the completion of the investigation in a few weeks.
