Job Description

Part-Time/Permanent Southern Resource Management Technician

The Resource Management Technician position will assist the Southern Resource Manager in duties that may include but are not limited to prescribed fire planning and application, exotic plant removal, hazardous tree removal, storm damage work, and native habitat restoration on state parks. This position is part-time, year-round with a strict limit of 29 hours a week. Must have a valid Georgia Class C driver's license.

Training – Training includes S130, I190 basic wildland firefighter training, ATV training, and chainsaw training. On-the-job training will include plant and animal identification, herbicides and exotic plants, and fire line preparation.

Requirements - A completed college degree is not required. Areas of study that would be most appropriate include, Biology, Ecology, Wildlife Management, Botany, Environmental Sciences, or other related field. Previous experience in a related field is also desirable. Experience in ArcMap, QGIS, small engine repair, or mechanical/carpentry may also be valuable for this position. Applicants must have strong communication skills and be able to work independently and have a passion for the outdoors.

Applicants also must be able to pass a work capacity test (walking 2 miles in 30 minutes with 25 lbs., or 3 miles in 45 minutes with 45 lbs.)

The area of work primarily consists of state parks located south of the I-20 corridor.
