DNR Law Enforcement Sergeant Promoted to Captain – Will Lead Coastal GA Region

SOCIAL CIRCLE, GA – Last week, the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Law Enforcement Division promoted Sergeant David Brady to the rank of Captain and announced that he will be the new supervisor of Region VI, which covers 19 counties in southeast Georgia and includes all of Georgia’s coastline. He steps into the vacancy created when Captain Chris Hodge was promoted to Colonel and director of the Division.

“With Captain Brady’s knowledge and experience, he will be an outstanding leader for our southeast Georgia region,” said Colonel Hodge. “He has a reputation of professionalism and hard work, and I am confident that will continue in his new assignment.”

Brady began his career with DNR in 2004 and has served most of his career in Region VI. He promoted to Sergeant in 2019.

During his 21-year career, he has served as a Field Training Officer for newly hired game wardens and been an active member of the Division's Honor Guard and the Special Operations Group. Brady is the lead instructor for the Officer Water Survival course at the Georgia Game Warden Academy, where he also teaches Defensive Tactics and ATV Operation.

Brady’s new role as Captain was effective on June 1st.
