TRAIL KEEPERS

Help us keep our trails looking their best. This program is for individuals, small or large groups, families, or scout troops that like to work outside. We ask that you commit to at least once a month of walking and maintaining our trails. Maintenance might include trimming limbs, raking leaves, clearing small trees, removing weeds, cleaning up trash or assessing trail conditions and reporting status to staff. All tools will be provided.
